

TRAVEL COSTS FOR CONFERENCES AND WORKSHOPS OF THE MULTI ANNUAL PROJECT

Travel costs: starting point at conferences and workshops is the amount that remains after the organisation costs are calculated. In order to bring more balance in the travel costs people have to make in proportion to their costs of living, the presidium has decided to make a system that corresponds with this idea. Basis is the daily rate the EU in Brussels counts for the different EU-countries. The president has developed a system that Brussels has approved.

This system is based upon the distance in kilometres as the crow flies (Google Earth). We have made a division: countries that have a high daily EU rate (and therefore also a higher income) and countries that have a low daily EU rate (and therefore a lower income). To stimulate the involvement of young people, we have decided to give a bit more refund of travel costs for the youth workshops.

participants from the A-list get 0,03 eurocent per km and participants from the B-list get 0,06 eurocent per km.

2. For travel costs concerning the youth meetings:
 - March 13th – 15th 2009, organised by Holmegaard (Naestved) Denmark
 - October 29th – 31st 2010, organised by Kandava Latviaparticipants from the A-list get paid 50% of the flight ticket and participants of the B-list get paid 70% of their flight ticket.

At the big citizens meetings (Stary Poddvorov and Strzyzow), the grant giver himself makes a division between organisation and travel costs.

Some time before the start of the different meetings, participants will get information from us about the amount of money they will receive for travel costs.
